Dear Parents/Caregivers,

ABPS students in Years 3-6 use the Literacy Pro Program during classroom literacy and library lessons. Literacy Pro is a levelled reading program that assesses both reader ability and text complexity. Students select and read a levelled Literacy Pro book and subsequently take a corresponding comprehension quiz using the online Literacy Pro platform.

This program is grounded in over 20 years of research and has been developed in consultation with the Australian Centre for Education Research (ACER). The program uses popular books, including a range of fiction and non-fiction titles from major children's book publishers, both Australian and international. A wide range of Lexile titles are available in our school library to support the program and foster an enjoyment of reading. New release Lexile titles with corresponding comprehension quizzes are added each term.

Each student in Years 3-6 has completed an online comprehension test and received an individual Lexile level to assist them in choosing books to read in conjunction with the program. The Literacy Pro student assessment test focuses on comprehension of increasingly difficult text complexity and vocabulary. Throughout the year students will have the opportunity to take subsequent assessment tests to monitor their progress.

The utility of the Lexile framework is that it places both reader and text on the same scale, making it easier to connect your child with books targeted to their reading ability. It provides teachers with a tool to set measurable goals and to monitor independent reading and comprehension. Research shows that the best way to motivate a child to read is to encourage self-selection. All students have opportunities to *read free choice books* below and above their own level for their own interest and pleasure, and we guide and encourage them to challenge themselves with <u>at least one</u> Literacy Pro book. Students are explicitly taught how to search the library catalogue in order to select quiz books from within their Lexile range that suit their reading interests. The library borrowing limit for primary is up to 4 books at any one time. Students can borrow and return during library lessons, 1<sup>st</sup> half of lunch, and before school if Ms Fyffe is in the library.

Consistent reading comprehension and vocabulary growth over time is the overarching goal of the Literacy Pro program. It enables the librarian and classroom teacher to work together to support your child's reading growth and to foster a love of language and reading for life.

**LITERACY PRO** - Here students can search for both library and e-book titles that have quizzes. Students can complete quizzes for any book they have read that is a Literacy Pro book providing they have read it this current school year, this includes books they have borrowed from a public library or that they may have in their own collection.



**LITERACY PRO LIBRARY -** Use this icon to access the entire Literacy Pro e-book collection. Students can self-select e-books to read at school and at home. They will also be assigned e-books by their teachers to work on during literacy sessions. Students can access the quizzes directly from the e-book within this app.




**ABPS LIBRARY - Oliver -** Use the general search or 'Reading List' search option to locate LitPro books within lexile categories. Within your search results, books with a LitPro icon have quizzes. Hover over the LitPro icon to see the lexile range. You can cross-check your book by searching on Literacy Pro to see the exact lexile. Students can email the library to request a book and can reserve books that are out on loan. If students have trouble finding a quiz they should see their teacher or Ms Fyffe. Most books in the library are labelled with a lexile and a bright green 'Q' if they have a LitPro quiz. Some older titles may not yet be labelled.
