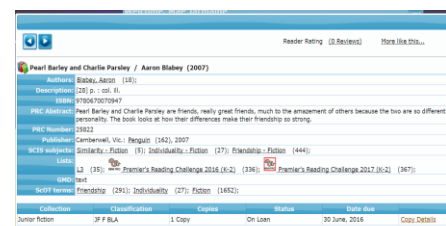
K-2 students can read the books on their own, read with someone, or someone can read to them.
