EXTENDED LEAVE from ATTENDANCE. If you are planning a family holiday during the school term, even if it is only for a few days, parents need to apply for an '**Application for Extended Leave**' from school. 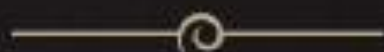
