2020 classes

At this stage, we seem certain to have 18 classes at Avoca Beach Public School in 2020. The formation of classes is a process that teachers go through each year. We have very strict departmental guidelines to work within and teachers will work collaboratively within these guidelines over the next few weeks and throughout the holidays so we can attempt to form classes as quick as possible next year. 
