#### Dear Parents,

The best learning environment for students is in the classroom and we are looking forward to welcoming back our staff and students over the next two weeks. We know that while there will be excitement, there will also be some anxiety and uncertainty about being back together at school. The teachers have been working through a range of wellbeing resources over the past few weeks to prepare themselves to support the return to school for all students. They have also been involved in extra personal professional learning, to further understand and be better equipped to support students experiencing sadness, fear, anxiety and worry.

I have listed below, further updates from the Department of Education, to support families in understanding how the school will operate upon returning.

#### **School attendance**

All students should be at school on the date indicated for their year group, unless:

- they have a medical certificate which says they can't return to school due to a condition or illness
- they are currently unwell
- they have been asked by NSW Health to self-isolate.

#### Wellbeing

If you are worried that the impacts of COVID-19 or going back to face-to-face learning may be affecting your child's wellbeing, please discuss this with your child's teacher. #### **Physical Distancing**

All adults must keep 1.5 metres distance from each other, including teachers and support staff, and parents and carers waiting outside the school grounds to collect children. Physical distancing between children in the same class is not required under the latest health guidelines. Mixing between class groups will be minimised and students will be supported to follow strict hygiene practices like:

- regularly washing hands
- not sharing drinks or food
- coughing or sneezing into their elbow, or else using a tissue which should be put in the bin straight away
- filling water bottles from bubblers rather than using the bubbler directly.

#### **School Cleaning & Hygiene Supplies**

Schools will continue to receive additional cleaning in line with advice from NSW Health. Schools have received extra supplies of soap, hand sanitiser, toilet paper, paper towels, disinfectant wipes and personal protective equipment and can order more as needed.

#### **Visitors**

Only essential visitors are allowed on school sites at this time. When dropping off or picking up your child, parents and carers need to stay outside school grounds and continue to physically distance.

#### **Responding to COVID-19 cases**

Where there is a case of COVID-19 in the school community, the department has established systems and protocols with NSW Health to manage and respond accordingly to keep our staff and students safe. These protocols include communication with parents or carers if their child has been in contact with someone who has tested positive to COVID-19 while at school or if the school becomes closed.

#### If the school becomes closed due to a COVID-19 case

Parents and students will be notified when a decision is made to make the school closed for onsite attendance due to a confirmed case of COVID-19 or other events that require the school to close. Information about the operational status of the school will be distributed through the school's information channels, including the school website, School App, school email distribution list and the department's website. During this period, the school will continue to provide learning activities for your child to do at home and will communicate with you about their learning. Parents and students will be informed by the department when the school is ready to resume onsite learning.

#### **Drop off**

If dropping students from cars at our kiss and drop area, please remain in your car and move from the kiss and drop area as soon as possible.

If walking with your child, please drop them at the front gate. Parents are unable to come onto the school grounds at this point in time.

#### **Before School Morning Routine**

Supervision of students begins at 9am. Upon arrival at school, Kindergarten and Year 1 students should put school bags at their classroom and then go straight to the bottom playground area. Year 2 will also do this, starting from Monday 25<sup>th</sup> October. Students in Yrs 2 – 6, who must attend school due to families being unable to support working from home, should put bags at their classroom and then go straight to the top playground. Teachers will be placed around the school grounds to meet students and direct them to the correct area.

#### **Uniforms**

It is now time to wear the summer uniform. We understand that some of our students may have grown out of this and are waiting for new uniforms. The uniform shop is starting to operate again and we will try to get uniforms out as soon as possible. We completely understand if students are not in full uniform for the first few weeks.

#### Canteen

The canteen will not start operation again until Monday 25th October.

#### Pick up

**Kiss & Drop**- Please do not arrive for collection at kiss and drop before 3.20pm. Display your surname place card in the windscreen (let the office know if you need a replacement) so we can get your child ready for pick up and make collection as fast as possible.

**Bottom Gates**- Please remain outside the school gates and adhere to physical distancing guidelines. Teachers will be there to dismiss the students.

**Bus**- Students will line up in their stage groups at the normal location.

#### Wall of Fame

I am so proud to announce this week's students for the wall of fame. Matilda Coleman, Matilda Harvey and Violette Wolters were acknowledged by Surf Lifesaving NSW and local media last month for their quick thinking and bravery when they rescued a man caught in a rip at Avoca Beach. 
