Dear Parents,

Week 5 is here and the students have had an amazing start to Term 2. The teachers have all been working very hard to provide a rich balance of academic, sporting, cultural and creative experiences for the students.

Attendance

Every school in NSW now has an attendance target that needs to be met and our school is focused on improving student attendance in line with our 2021 – 2024 Strategic Improvement Plan. The aim is to increase the amount of students whose attendance is at 90% or greater. In 2022, our target is to have 83% of students, attending school 90% of the time or more. We acknowledge that COVID-19 has impacted attendance this year, but so far, our attendance rate at 90% or above, is sitting at 67%. We are hoping to work with families to improve on this over the next two terms.

Applications for Extended Leave

The Department of Education discourages travel, in the form of family holidays, during school time. However, if you do need to travel during the school term, an Application for Extended leave form must be completed. These forms are available from the front office and should be completed before the travel period. Documentation such as a travel itinerary or e-ticket are required to be attached to these forms. A Certificate of Extended Leave will be provided following submission of the application.

Enrol for Kindergarten 2023

As we near the second half of the year, it is time to start calling for enrolment applications for 2023. If you have a child starting in 2023 or you know of someone in the community who does, please come into the school to start the enrolment process.

Buddy Program

It has been so nice to see our buddy program up and running again this year. The purpose of our buddy program is to support a smooth transition for children starting school and in the early years of their schooling. However, the benefits of our buddy program are much more than just that. Our programs promote social and support networks, a sense of community and a sense of belonging in the school. I also love seeing how caring our older students are with their buddies and the leadership skills that they develop throughout the process.

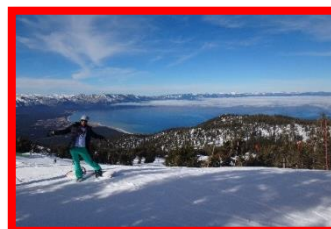
I have been lucky enough to have worked at Avoca Beach Public School for 7 years now as an Assistant Principal. There is not a day that goes by that I do not feel grateful and privileged to live and work in such an incredibly beautiful place on the Central Coast. I made the sea change after missing the beach life I once had as a child growing up. After years of doing the 2-hour commute to and from work each day battling the Sydney traffic, it was time for a change. When the opportunity arose to apply at Avoca, I jumped at the chance!

Before moving up to the Central Coast I worked in South Western Sydney schools as both a teacher and an Assistant Principal. Finally, thank you to each and every person who has volunteered their very valuable time to help out at any P&C events over the past 12 months, it's very true what they say that "many hands make light work". Without your hands the events we run to raise funds for the school would not be near as successful, and in most cases not possible.

I look forward to a successful year ahead with the continuing partnership between the P&C, school community and Avoca Beach Public School.
