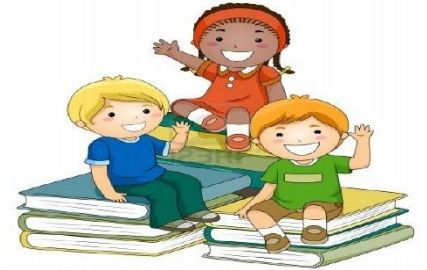

Each term a Stage Newsletter is sent home with information about the term ahead, including relevant information involving excursions, resources and topics being learned.

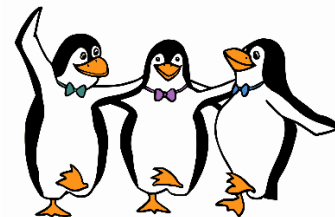
